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### **ABORIGINAL MINISTRIES COUNCIL FONDS. --1995-2016. --2.85 m of textual records. --185 photographs.**

Participants at the 2005 Aboriginal Consultation in Sudbury strongly recommended that Aboriginal peoples become partners in the work of The United Church of Canada through the establishment of an Aboriginal Ministries Unit. The Aboriginal Ministries Steering Committee was established in 2006 to undertake a process of consultation and discernment with Aboriginal members and others within the church about a National Aboriginal Council and Aboriginal Ministries Unit. A report of the Steering Committee, entitled "Giving Voice to a Vision" was presented to the General Council Executive in November, 2008. Based on the adopted report, the Aboriginal Ministries Council, with the purpose of overseeing and guiding the work of Aboriginal Ministries was created and to be implemented by an Aboriginal Ministries Council Implementation Task Group. The inaugural meeting was held in September, 2009. A staff team in the General Council office is called Aboriginal Ministries Circle and works in partnership with The United Church to apply Aboriginal people's vision of spiritual healing, stewardship, and economic well-being. A large part of their work is the National Aboriginal Spiritual Gatherings which provide an opportunity to share and nurture the vision of the Circle. The Aboriginal Ministries Council takes direction from the Spiritual Gatherings and sends this work to the Executive of the General Council. It also reflects and takes into consideration the documented meetings of the Aboriginal Ministries Steering Committee, the All Native Circle Conference, and Aboriginal Presbyteries which document and reflect the voice of the Aboriginal community. The Council supports approximately 52-56 Native Ministries, including congregations and outreach ministries. The Healing Fund and the Towards Right Relations Task Group both report to the Council.

### **SERIES 4\RECORDS OF HEALING FUND COUNCIL. --2005-2013.**

The Healing Fund Council comprises of representatives from Aboriginal United Church congregations across Canada, and meets twice a year to disburse funds to Aboriginal communities' projects, based on various guidelines. At the 35<sup>th</sup> General Council (1994), the Bay of Quinte conference presented Petition No. 112 entitled "Fund for Healing- Native People of Canada". The original text for the petition originated with the Division of Mission in Canada Residential School Advisory Group. It was resolved by the General Council that a "Fund for Healing" be established with the initial goal of raising \$1 million over a four year period (1995-1998), and that all efforts of the Healing Fund be coordinated by the Division of Mission in Canada. The Healing Fund had a Technical Implementation Group, which was established in British Columbia to take advantage of the expertise gained in that Conference through the successful effort of the B.C. Land Claims Fund. The TIG provided oversight of strategic planning and production of campaign materials. With the completion of the mandate of the DMC Advisory Group, the TIG continued

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to be accountable for the Healing Fund directly to the DMC Executive. The fundraising period was extended in 1999 as the monetary goal had not been raised. In November 2004, the General Council Executive affirmed the work of the Healing Fund Council and re-mandated its work of discerning which local projects best fit the goal of healing and cultural restoration in First Nations communities. The executive also approved a position to staff the Healing Fund. It continues as one facet of the United Church's ongoing reconciliation work with Aboriginal people.

The Healing Fund was originally coordinated by the Division of Mission in Canada. In the 2001 reorganization of the DMC, oversight of the Healing Fund was transferred to the newly created Support to Local Ministries working unit, which worked with Aboriginal Ministries. In 2005, the Healing Fund was re-mandated and a full-time Healing Fund program coordinator position was created and filled. In 2006, Aboriginal Ministries, including the Healing Fund, migrated organizationally to report to the General Council Minister, Racial and Gender Justice. The Healing Fund Council now reports to the Aboriginal Ministries Council. *For earlier records of the Healing Fund, see also: Division of Mission in Canada Fonds and Support to Local Ministries Unit Fonds.*
