EVELYN G. BUCHANAN FONDS. –1861-1970. – 46 cm of textual records. – 497 photographs.

Mary Evelyn Greig Buchanan (b.1886) was a teacher, and a missionary to China and India. She was born in Levis, Quebec, and taught public school in Montreal and Lethbridge for thirteen years. She also spent seven years teaching primary school in Canton, China, arriving in 1922. She was appointed to Honan, China, by the Board of Foreign Missions in 1934 to teach school. From 1946-1951, she served at the Woodstock School in Mussoorie, India which from 1927 was partly supported by the United Church of Canada. Buchanan died in 1978.

Fonds consists of two series: 1) Personal Papers, 1917-1962, 2) Photographs, 1861-1970.
