METHODIST NATIONAL TRAINING SCHOOL FONDS. – 1898-1926. – 24 cm of textual records. – 30 photographs.

The Methodist National training School was first established as the Toronto Deaconess Home and Training Centre in 1898, with a mandate to train women for deaconess work. It changed its name to the Methodist National Training School in 1910, and in 1926 joined with the Presbyterian Missionary and Deaconess Training Home to form the United Church Training School

Fonds consists of two series; 1) Textual Records, 1898-1923, and 2) Photographs, 1911-1925.
