ROBERT BROCK SAUNDERS FONDS.—1981-2000. – 2 cm of textual records. –6 photographs.

Robert Brock Saunders (1935-) was a United Church minister in Manitoba and Ontario. He was born in Winnipeg and was ordained in Portage La Prairie, Manitoba, 1965. He graduated with a B.A. from United Winnipeg 1962, a Theology degree from United Winnipeg 1965, and a Master of Divinity from University of Winnipeg 1987. He served at the following charges: Portage Presbytery (1960-1962), Macdonald, Portage Presbytery (1962—1965), Northwest Inverlake (1965-1969), Lake of the Woods, Cambrian (1969-1974), Courtright, Lambton Presbytery (1974-1978) and Olivet, Waterloo Presbytery (1978-). Throughout his ministerial career he also held the following positions: Secretary (Kenora Rainey River), Chair of Education (Cambrian), Chair of Communications (London Conference), Chair of Communications (Waterloo Presbytery), Presbytery Representative: Conference Education (Waterloo). He also worked within the following church bodies: Boundary Committee (Manitoba Conference), Native Ordination and Education (Manitoba), National Communication Division, Education and Students Cambrian (Waterloo) and Vice Chair Conference Education and Students. He married Elizabeth Gibson in 1961 and had three children; Heather, Carolyn and Robert.
