RUTH EVANS FONDS. – 1970-1995. – 40 cm of textual records. – 1 photograph.

Ruth Evans was born in Warwick, England in 1930. She earned an honours B.A in 1952 and an M.A in 1956, both from Oxford. She later earned an M.A. from the Toronto School of Theology in 1980. She was the founder and executive secretary of the Toronto branch of the Association for the Repeal of the Canadian Abortion Law (ARCAL), and developed this into the Association for Contraceptive Counselling and Related Areas (ACCRA) for which she was the first Chairperson of the Board of Directors. With the church she acted as Chairperson of the United Church Committee on Abortion, and spoke on the report at 24th General Council, 1971. A member of the United Church Commission on Abortion 1975, and worked on the theological review and clarification submitted to General council in 1980. She was a member of the Conference Task force to raise consciousness in the church on the position of women, 1980. She worked for the Division of Mission in Canada and Director of the Office of Christian Development at General Council offices.
