SIDNEY BARLOW STOKES FONDS. – 1914-1984. – 61 cm of textual records. –1 scrapbook; --19 photographs.

Sidney Barley Stokes (1890-1993) was a Methodist/United Church minister in Ontario. He was born in England in 1890. Ordained in Hamilton Conference in 1921 he served various charges in Ontario until he was appointed superintendent of Home Missions for Southern Ontario in 1952. Rev. Stokes retired in 1957 and died in 1993.

Fonds consists of the three series: 1) Records relating to ministry, 1914-1984, 2) Records relating to work with Hamilton Conference, [195-]-1983, 3) Scrapbooks and Photographs, 1911-1960.

SERIES 1: RECORDS RELATING TO MINISTRY. – 1914-1984

Series contains bulletins, notes, sermons, addresses, baptism/marriage/burial records, and correspondence, 1914-1984. Records include baptisms, marriages and burials at Port Robinson Circuit, Troy, Orton and Old Windham Stations, East and West Plains (Aldershot), Chesley, Lundy's Lane (Niagara Falls) and Melrose (Hamilton) churches, all in Hamilton Conference; records of Lundy's Lane United Church; newsletters and correspondence of Ryerson Beach Sunday School.
