UNITED CHURCH OF CANADA BOARD OF MEN FONDS. --1948-1972, predominant 1954-1971. - -3 m of textual records. --9 audio discs. --13 slides.

The Board of Men was established in 1954 as a successor to the National Committee of United Church Men, itself a successor to the Committee on Lay Activities. In 1964 the Board became part of the Division of Congregational Life and Work while maintaining its independence of action. It was absorbed into the Division of Mission in Canada in 1972.

The Committee on Lay Activities was established in 1948 by General Council, in response to a request by the Lay Advisory Council for the appointment of a full-time Secretary to co-ordinate and promote lay involvement in the Church's work. At a two-day conference of the entire Committee in the following year, it was decided to set up a new organization to be known as "United Church Men." The committee was replaced in 1950 by a National Committee of United Church Men. It was recognized by the General Council that this Committee was in reality functioning as an administrative board of the Church, and a new designation as the Board of Men was given in 1954. Although the Board became part of the Division of Congregational Life and Work in 1964, this Division played only a co-ordinating role and the Board retained a measure of independence. Its last annual and executive meetings were held in 1971, before its functions were fully absorbed into the new Division of Mission in Canada the following year.

The Board of Men's purpose was to lead laymen into a deeper spiritual life and involvement with the Church's work and programmes. A main function was to promote the formation of men's groups, not only by working with existing United Church Men's clubs, fellowships, and brotherhoods in the pastoral charges, but also by working with newly created United Church Men's Councils at the Presbytery and Conference levels. The goal was to integrate all men's work programmes, in particular by bringing the Western Canada-based AOTS men's club movement fully into the Board structure. This was accomplished in stages: first by making the AOTS National Council a department of the Board (since 1952), then by changing this department into a more integrated National Association of United Church AOTS Men's Clubs in 1959, and finally by making this the Men's Club Committee (more directly responsible for all types of U.C. men's clubs) of the Board in 1964. The first National Conference of United Church Men was held in Muskoka, Ont., in 1953, and became an annual event; annual national conferences were also held in Western Canada (Banff) starting in 1955, and in Atlantic Canada from 1964. The Board had additional responsibilities for leadership development (Elders and Stewards Schools), "Christianity and Daily Work" concerns, and for producing pamphlets, booklets, national newsletters, and printed materials for Laymen's Sunday. It worked co-operatively with many Church departments and agencies, particularly in the areas of recruiting Church workers and lay employees. Boy's and Youth Work, the Lay School of Theology, Lay Foundations for assisting theological students, and Operation Crossroads Africa.

Secretaries of the Board were: Ralph C. Young, 1954-1961; Donald Cameron (Acting Secretary), 1961-1964; Ralph F. Wilson, 1965-1969; and Donald G. Smith (Associate Secretary), 1970-1972.

SERIES 2: SECRETARY'S CORRESPONDENCE/SUBJECT FILES. --1949-1971. --48 cm of textual records.

The United Church's first full-time Secretary for lay concerns jointly served both the Committee on Lay Activities and the Lay Advisory Council (the Council was disbanded in 1962). W.J. Holliday was the first appointee in 1948, leaving the position at the end of 1950. By this time the committee name had changed to National Association of United Church Men, and Ralph Young served from 1951 (becoming Secretary of Board of Men three years later) to 1961. Donald Cameron served as Acting Secretary 1961-1964.

Ralph Wilson, who had served as Associate Secretary, was appointed to the post in 1965 and served until 1968. Phil Spence, a long-time field secretary, served as Acting Secretary for an interim period. The last Board Secretary (1970-1971), was Don Smith, who had served as Assistant Secretary since 1965, and went on to become an Associate Secretary of the new Division of Mission in Canada.

Series consists of records dated 1949-1971 which relate to: Committee on Lay Activities and National Committee of United Church Men; AOTS movement and its integration into the Committee/Board; relations with General Council, other administrative boards and committees; lay consultations and conferences; the 1969 Evaluation Survey of its organization and major activities across the country; and alphabetically arranged files on subjects such as the history of men's work in the Church and Operation Crossroads Africa.

Series consists of records of various committees: Leadership Development Committee, including correspondence and teaching materials re Elders and Stewards Schools, reports and printed materials re Eldership and Stewardship, 1950s-1960s; Christianity and Daily Work Committee, including materials re ethics for business executives, industrial relations and labour issues, the role of Christian commitment in the world of work, 1950s-1960s; Elgin House-Keswick Conference Committee, including extensive records re planning, promotion, and programme of all the National Conferences held annually in Muskoka, Ont., 1953-1971; Banff Conference Committee, including mostly printed items for all but two annual conferences for men in Western Canada, 1955-1971; as well as some minutes of the Book Committee, Men's Conferences and Retreats Committee, Public Relations / Editorial and Publications / Communications Committee, Stewardship Committee, and United Church Men's Groups Committee.

SERIES 4: RECORDS RELATING TO LAY ASSOCIATIONS AND UNITED CHURCH MEN'S COUNCILS AND THE CONFERENCE AND PRESBYTERY LEVELS. --1978-1971. Predominant 1953-1967. --72 cm of textual records.

Lay Associations had been in existence since the time of Church Union, although many were not active until the 1940s. With the formation of the National Committee of United Church Men in 1950, one of its aims was to promote the establishment of United Church Men's Councils at the Conference and Presbytery levels throughout the Church. Some of the Lay Associations continued to exist until their Constitution was taken out of the Church Manual in 1962. When the AOTS movement was

brought into the United Church structure in 1952, there was an effort to integrate the AOTS Provincial and District Councils with the United Church Men's Councils. In 1964, a change was made to bring responsibility for AOTS and other men's groups under a Men's Club Committee for each UCM Council.

Series consists of: correspondence with representatives of Conference and Presbytery Lay Associations, United Church Men's Councils and their Men's Club Committees, and in some cases AOTS District Councils; annual reports to Board of Men and some minutes of these organizations; records relating to men's conferences, forums, leader training events, and other activities at regional and local levels. Although there are a few records dating from the late 1940s and early 1950s, most date from the late 1950s and 1960s.

Note: Headings below refer to records kept by Board of Men, not to records kept by Conferences and Presbyteries.
