<u>FONDS 1009: UNITED CHURCH OF CANADA HAMILTON CONFERENCE FONDS. – 1925-2018. – m</u> of textual records and 326 photographs

Conferences in the United Church of Canada are courts of the Church organized as an administrative grouping of Presbyteries in a geographical area. The Conference is governed by a body consisting of ministers within its boundaries and an equal number of non-ministerial representatives of Pastoral Charges. Functions of a Conference include the following: determining boundaries and numbers of Presbyteries within its bounds; receiving and disposing of appeals, petitions subject to the usual right to appeal; sustaining pastorate in every Pastoral Charge; examining and ordaining candidates for the Order of Ministry; receiving ministers and deaconesses from other Churches; dealing with matters referred to it by the General Council and selecting equal numbers of members of the Order of Ministry and lay representatives to the General Council.

Hamilton Conference was established in 1925. The inaugural meeting of Hamilton Conference took place at First United Church in Hamilton, Ontario on October 5, 1925. At the time of its formation the Conference encompassed the following Presbyteries: Brant, Bruce, Guelph, Niagara, North Wellington and Wentworth and South Halton. In 1927, Haldimand, Hamilton, Norfolk and Waterloo were added with North Wellington and Wentworth amalgamated into existing Presbyteries.

Hamilton Conference disbanded on December 31, 2018 with the reorganization of the United Church court structure. Communities of faith within Hamilton Conference became part of Western Ontario Waterways and Horseshoe Falls Regional Councils.

The Executive Secretary title was created in 1971, and was based on the former Secretary position: responsibilities included keeping a record of proceedings of the Conference; keeping an accurate roll of members and compiling other statistics concerning pastoral charges and ministers; conducting correspondence pursuant to the proceedings of the Conference; facilitating Presbytery procedures with training and support; acting as a resource person in new church development areas; and communicating and interpreting the policies and actions of the national Church Offices.

<u>SERIES 4: RECORDS OF THE HOME MISSION and CHURCH EXTENSION COMMITTEES. – 60 cm of textual records. – 1941-1979</u>

The Church Extension Committees were established in 1947 to survey existing allocation of resources, establish Church Extension Councils and Presbytery committees, plan through the Mission and Service fund to assist the building of churches through local and Presbytery campaigns and fund ministers to work in new locations. The Conference's Church Extension Policy, revised in 1969, had as its purpose the establishment of a standard by which Presbyteries could assist church extension congregations. The Church Extension Committees of Conference distributed funds to Presbyteries on the basis of need. The funds in turn would be distributed at the Presbytery level for new sites, building costs, financial emergency and extension of building structures. In 1970 plans were made to introduce block grant programmes (also called missionary and maintenance funds) to Conferences for the purpose of assisting Pastoral Charges with special ministries, institutions and summer students. These programmes placed the decision-making power in the hands of the Presbytery and congregation. The establishment of this new block grant system involving transfer of funds from the Conference coincided with the reorganization of the Board of Home Missions into the Division of Mission in Canada. The block grants could be for property maintenance, minor renovations and extensions. No grants were passed without a recommendation from Presbytery or Conference Home Mission Committees or the Executives

SERIES 4: RECORDS OF THE MISSION ACTION FORCE, 1972-1989

The Mission in Action Force was established in 1972 by Hamilton Conference to promote mission and outreach of the Church primarily in areas beyond the reach of the congregation and coordinate mission work in the Conference. Its function included developing a relationship with all agencies assisting in outreach of the Church; supporting and evaluating Conference institutions and projects; determining block grants and Conference capital funds; making recommendations for support of special projects, and working closely with Presbytery and Church Extension Councils. The Action Force was administered by a Steering Committee which appointed Standing Committees and Task Groups on mission issues of relevance to the Conference. While this structure was intended to be more flexible and less permanent in composition than traditional Standing Committees of Conference, it did require that the following Committees be constituted: Stewardship (promotes and communicates work of the Church to Conference

and gives leadership through Presbytery in stewardship programmes); Institutional Support and Evaluation (support and oversight of all institutional work that is the responsibility of Conference); Ecumenical Affairs (promotes closer working relationship with other denominations); and Communications.
