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FONDS 1028 UNITED CHURCH OF CANADA MANITOU CONFERENCE FONDS. -- 1956-2018. -- 3.08 m of textual records. -- 48 photographs.

Conferences in the United Church of Canada are Church courts organized as an administrative grouping of Presbyteries in a geographical area. The Conference is governed by a body consisting of ministers within its boundaries and an equal number of non-ministerial representatives of Pastoral Charges. Functions of a Conference include the following: determining boundaries and numbers of Presbyteries within its bounds; receiving and disposing of appeals and petitions subject to the usual right to appeal; sustaining pastorate in every Pastoral Charge; examining and ordaining candidates for the Order of Ministry; receiving ministers and deaconesses from other Churches; dealing with matters referred to it by the General Council and selecting equal numbers of members of the Order of Ministry and lay representatives to the General Council.

Manitou Conference was established in 1975 as the twelfth Conference of the United Church of Canada to represent the communities of Northeastern Ontario and Northwestern Quebec. The inaugural meeting was held at First United Church, Timmins Ontario from June 19-21, 1975. The Conference originally encompassed the Cochrane, North Bay, Sudbury and Temiskaming Presbyteries. Cochrane and Temiskaming Presbyteries amalgamated in the fall of 2007 to form Spirit Dancing Presbytery.

In September 2015, the Manitou Conference office located at Omond Memorial United Church (North Bay, Ont.), was destroyed by fire, including their computer drives and paper records. Only some vital records were recovered. Manitou Conference disbanded on December 31, 2018 with the reorganization of the United Church of Canada court structure. Communities of faith within the boundaries of Manitou Conference became part of Canadian Shield Regional Council.

Manitou Conference met annually from 1975 to 1992; however, at the 1992 annual meeting, Conference moved to meet every two years. Series consists of the record of the Conference's annual meeting, referred to as the "Record of Proceedings." In addition to the minutes of the annual meeting, a Record of Proceedings may also include a history of the Conference, compiled minutes of the Executive Committee meetings for that year, reports and the agenda distributed prior to an annual meeting, a Conference directory and an index of motions. Series consists of official and unofficial records of proceedings of annual/general meetings and executive minutes, 1975-2012; annual meeting report books, 1989-1995; and general meeting correspondence and reports, 2002-2003, 2007. Records of Proceedings and executive minutes from 1982 to 1990 are bound.

SERIES 4: RECORDS CONCERNING THE FORMATION OF MANITOU CONFERENCE. -- 1956-1975.

In 1962, the Sub-Executive of the General Council of United Church appointed a Commission on Conference Boundaries to consider the realignment of Conference boundaries in light of present needs, administrative responsibilities and modern means of communications. Another Commission (of the same name) was established by the Executive of General Council in May 1971 to study, among other things, the feasibility of a northern Conference. The Commission reported to the General Council of 1972 to establish a northern Conference. The bulk of the Commission's recommendations were referred to a negotiating committee which became known as the Committee for a Proposed Northern Ontario Conference. This Committee reported to the Twenty-sixth General Council (1974). A Commission to Establish the New Conference was formed in 1974 and in 1975 Manitou Conference was established.

The position of the Conference Minister of Mission and Stewardship was responsible for: providing staff leadership, support and liaison in the areas of church life that were served by the National Division of Mission in Canada and the Department of Stewardship Services and their subsequent bodies; providing administrative support to committees and pastoral charges in the areas of grants and other funding sources; exploring and developing the Conference role in relation to innovative evangelism, outreach and social issues; and engaging in ecumenical, community and personal ministries that will enhance the mission of the church. It was later named Minister of Mission & Stewardship Animation in 2008.

The position has been held by Rev. J. Stewart Bell (1976-1984), Rev. Robert L. Jackson (1985-2005), and Rev. Melody Duncanson Hales (2008-current)
